

Other issues...

- Multi-family parking: SF residents having same issues; friends and family; spaces not accessible next to the swale;
 - ▣ Access for children, extra cars
- Removal of curbs that were formerly there
- Parking by visitors in treelawn
- Streets turned to one-lane with back to back parking...who yields?
- Street degradation because of people driving off the swale (no curbs)
- Soggy swales, swales being compacted; liability during special events

Other issues...

- Families with multiple cars that cannot fit in driveways
- People willing to pay for curbs? Approach residents
- School traffic (family and bus traffic) – difficult to get out of driveways
- Garbage from construction crews; broken sidewalks
- Emergency access during construction
- People willing to pay for parking bump-outs?

Other issues...

- Moving forward with Phase II and III before Phase I is corrected
- Restoration and funding of additional parking; and how to pay for it
- Water sitting in swales; mud, difficult to mow
- Code enforcement for not mowing swales; consistency with Phase I properties
- Clay soils in swales
- Dedicated parking for residents in front of own homes
